

Andaman & Nicobar Islands NEET UG Seat Matrix 2025

MBBS & BDS Seats — Category Wise, Course Wise Breakdown

Andaman & Nicobar Islands has a single government medical college — the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS), Sri Vijaya Puram (Port Blair) — established in 2015 and affiliated to Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Institute of Higher Learning (NSCBIHL). There is **no BDS (dental) college** in the Union Territory. Admission to the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats is through the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC); the 85% local/State Quota seats are counselled by ANIIMS and the Department of Higher Education (Common College Admission Portal, CCAP), Andaman & Nicobar Administration.

BDS Seat Matrix 2025-26

Andaman & Nicobar Islands has no functioning government or private dental (BDS) college, so **no BDS seats are offered within the Union Territory** under NEET UG counselling for 2025. A&N domicile candidates may compete for BDS (and BAMS/BHMS) seats in other states through the 15% AIQ counselling conducted by MCC. Separately, the A&N Administration also nominates a small number of local candidates each year to reserved BDS/BAMS/BHMS seats in institutions outside the Islands (e.g. under the Malayalee-origin nomination scheme) through its own Common College Admission Portal (CCAP) process — this is a nomination facility, not a seat matrix within the UT.

Note: 10 EWS seats are calculated as 10% of the original intake capacity of 100 (before the seat matrix was expanded to 114), while the remaining 87 seats form the local State/UT Quota, per the official ANIIMS MBBS Prospectus.

Category-wise Seat Allocation — State/UT Quota (87 Seats)

The 87 State/UT Quota seats (excluding EWS) are distributed among five local categories as per the 1996 Ministry of Home Affairs distribution scheme (Order No. V-14040/5/96-ANL dated 30 May 1996), as reproduced in the official ANIIMS MBBS Prospectus:

*Category-III (44 seats) is rotated in a 3-year block. For the current cycle: Groups (a) Pre-1942 Settlers and (b) Other Settlers each get 15 seats, and Group (c) Combined Merit gets 14 seats. In the following year, (b) & (c) will each get 15 seats and (a) will get 14; the rotation continues in the third year with (c) & (a) getting 15 each and (b) getting 14 — ensuring equitable rotation across the three settler sub-groups over a 3-year cycle. Any unutilized seats in Categories I-IV pass to Category-V (General Merit, open to all A&N residents); unutilized AIQ or EWS seats also revert first to Categories I-IV before going to Category-V.

Category-wise Reservation — All India Quota (17 Seats)

The 17 AIQ seats at ANIIMS follow the uniform central reservation policy applicable across all states/UTs for AIQ counselling: 27% OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), 15% SC, 7.5% ST, 10% EWS, and 5% horizontal reservation for PwBD candidates, applied within each category. No A&N domicile is required for AIQ seats.

Approximate seat splits are arithmetic estimates applying the national percentages to 17 AIQ seats, rounded to the nearest whole seat; MCC's official round-wise seat matrix should be checked for the exact allotted number in each counselling round.

Counselling Process

State/UT Quota counselling for ANIIMS is conducted by ANIIMS and the Common College Admission Portal (CCAP) of the A&N Administration, typically in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3, and a Stray Vacancy round if required. AIQ seats are counselled in parallel by MCC (mcc.nic.in). Candidates claiming a State/UT category (I-V) must submit the prescribed category certificate (Tehsildar-attested for Categories I, III, IV; Head of Department-attested for Category II) at the time of counselling.
