

Dadra & Nagar Haveli NEET UG Seat Matrix 2025

MBBS & BDS Seats — Category Wise, Course Wise Breakdown

Dadra & Nagar Haveli (part of the merged Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu) has a single government medical college — NAMO Medical Education & Research Institute, Silvassa (formerly Shri Vinoba Bhave Institute of Medical Sciences), established in 2019 and attached to Shri Vinoba Bhave Civil Hospital. There is **no BDS (dental) college** in the UT. The 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats are counselled by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC); the 85% State/UT Quota seats are counselled along with Gujarat's state quota process by the Admission Committee for Professional Undergraduate Medical Educational Courses (ACPUGMEC), Gujarat, since candidates from Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu are administratively grouped with the Gujarat state counselling pool for this college.

BDS Seat Matrix 2025-26

Dadra & Nagar Haveli has no functioning government or private dental (BDS) college, so **no BDS seats are offered within the UT** under NEET UG counselling for 2025. Candidates domiciled in Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu who wish to pursue BDS must compete for seats in other states — either through the 15% AIQ counselling conducted by MCC (open to all candidates nationally), or by seeking Gujarat state-quota BDS seats where DNH&DD candidates are eligible under the same administrative arrangement that covers their MBBS state quota.

Category-wise Reservation — All India Quota (~27 Seats)

AIQ seats follow the uniform central reservation policy applicable across all states/UTs: 27% OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), 15% SC, 7.5% ST, 10% EWS, and 5% horizontal reservation for PwBD candidates, applied within each category. No DNH domicile is required for AIQ seats.

Approximate seat splits are arithmetic estimates applying the national percentages to ~27 AIQ seats, rounded to the nearest whole seat; MCC's official round-wise seat matrix should be checked for the exact allotted number in each counselling round.

Category-wise Reservation — State/UT Quota (~150 Seats)

Since the State/UT Quota seats of this college are counselled jointly with Gujarat's state quota process by ACPUGMEC, the reservation categories applied generally mirror Gujarat's own state reservation framework (Gujarat uses "SEBC" — Socially and Educationally Backward Class — instead of the term OBC):

Note: DNH & Daman-Diu Administration has not published a separate, independent category-wise notification specific to this college distinct from the Gujarat ACPUGMEC framework it participates in; the percentages above reflect Gujarat's published state reservation policy, which is applied to candidates from Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu admitted through the joint counselling process. Approximate seat splits are arithmetic estimates; candidates should verify exact category-wise numbers from the official ACPUGMEC

Counselling Process

State/UT Quota counselling for this college is conducted jointly with Gujarat's state quota process via the ACPUGMEC online portal (medadmgujarat.org), typically across Round 1, Round 2, mop-up, and stray vacancy rounds. AIQ seats are counselled in parallel by MCC (mcc.nic.in). Candidates should carry a valid domicile/residence proof for Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, along with category certificates (SC/ST/SEBC/EWS/PwD, as applicable) issued by the competent authority.
