Note: Of the 22 AIQ seats, allotment is done centrally by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), New Delhi. Any AIQ seats reverted as vacant are filled by the Institute in the same category in which MCC allocated them. UT-domicile seats (Dadra & Nagar Haveli / Daman & Diu) additionally carry internal reservation for ST, SC, OBC and Unreserved candidates as per the applicable roster.

- Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu is a merged Union Territory. NAMO Medical Education and Research Institute, Silvassa (Government) is the sole MBBS college; Vaidik Dental College and Research Centre, Daman (Private) is the sole BDS college in the UT.
- NAMO Medical College's total MBBS intake of 177 seats is confirmed by the National Medical Commission's official college-wise UG seat matrix.
- 15% of MBBS seats (22 seats) go to the All India Quota, counselled centrally by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC); the remaining 85% are filled by DMHS Daman & Diu / the Institute across UT-domicile, Gujarat-nominated, Coast Guard, UT-employee-ward, and Ex-servicemen categories.
- UT-domicile seats are split roughly evenly between candidates of Dadra & Nagar Haveli (58 seats) and candidates of Daman & Diu (57 seats), each with a separate EWS allocation (15 and 12 seats respectively).
- BDS seats at Vaidik Dental College are entirely under a private college framework, with 15% AIQ and 85% state quota, following the standard national pattern for private dental colleges.
- Seat numbers can shift slightly round to round (Round 2 / Mop-Up) based on vacancies, MCC seat reversions, and any NMC-approved seat revisions. Always cross-check the live matrix published by DMHS Daman & Diu / the Institute before choice-filling.
