MBBS & BDS — Category-wise, Course-wise Seat Database

1. State Overview

Goa has only **one government medical college** — Goa Medical College & Hospital (GMC), Bambolim — and **one government dental college** — Goa Dental College & Hospital (GDCH), Bambolim. There are currently **no private medical or dental colleges** in the state. Admissions are based on NEET-UG 2025 scores. The **Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Government of Goa** conducts counselling for the 85% state-quota seats, while the **Medical Counselling Committee (MCC)** conducts counselling for the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats. Both colleges are affiliated with Goa University.

2.1 MBBS — Category-wise Seat Distribution (Total 200 seats)

5. Key Facts / FAQ

Q. Does Goa have any private medical or dental college?

No. As of 2025, all MBBS and BDS seats in Goa are at the two government institutes — GMC (MBBS) and GDCH (BDS) — both at Bambolim.

Q. How many total MBBS seats does Goa Medical College offer?

200 MBBS seats as per the NMC's official 2025 state-wise seat matrix, including 30 EWS seats — an increase from the earlier intake of 180.

Q. How many total BDS seats does Goa Dental College offer?

50 BDS seats (annual intake), up from the college's original 40-seat intake.

Q. What is the AIQ vs State Quota split?

15% of seats in both GMC and GDCH go to the All India Quota (AIQ), filled by MCC; the remaining 85% are State Quota seats reserved for Goa-domicile candidates, filled by DTE Goa.

Q. What is the domicile / residency requirement for state quota?

Candidates must have 10 years' residency in Goa, or 5 years if a parent/grandparent is Goan by birth or a Goa government employee on deputation.

Q. Who conducts Goa's NEET UG counselling?

The Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Goa (Porvorim/Bardez office) conducts the state-quota counselling in 2–3 rounds (including a mop-up round); MCC conducts the AIQ counselling.
