

Haryana NEET UG Seat Matrix 2025

MBBS & BDS — Government and Private Colleges | Category-wise & Course-wise Seats

This document compiles the Haryana NEET UG 2025 seat matrix released by the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER), Haryana, and Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences (UHS), Rohtak. As per the released matrix, Haryana has **1,515 MBBS seats** across government and private medical colleges, and **634 BDS seats** across 7 dental colleges. Seat numbers were further revised in Round 2 (2025) with ~200 newly added MBBS seats from two new government colleges — Bhiwani and Koriawas (Mahendragarh). **Always verify the live, round-wise matrix on dmer.haryana.gov.in / uhsrugcounselling.com before choice-filling.**

Medical College, Bhiwani and Govt. Medical College, Koriawas (Mahendragarh) — contributed approximately 200 newly added MBBS seats, revising the state total upward.
