

Manipur NEET UG Seat Matrix 2025

MBBS & BDS seats — college-wise, quota-wise and category-wise distribution across Manipur's medical and dental colleges

Counselling authority: **Directorate of Health Services (DHS), Government of Manipur** — conducts state-quota (85%) MBBS/BDS counselling for government colleges and 100% counselling for the private college, through the Manipur Medical Council e-counselling portal (manipurmc.mn.gov.in). The 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats in government colleges are filled separately by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) at mcc.nic.in.

Overall state totals (2025-26): 525 MBBS seats across 4 colleges (3 government + 1 private); 100 BDS seats across 2 government dental colleges. No new medical or dental college, and no seat increase, has been approved for Manipur for the 2025-26 or 2026-27 sessions.

1. MBBS Seat Matrix — College-wise

Regional Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Imphal is an autonomous central-government institute under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and additionally serves as the designated medical college for several neighbouring North-Eastern states (see Section 2). JNIMS and GMC Churachandpur are Manipur state-government colleges following the standard 15% AIQ / 85% state-quota split. Shija Academy is Manipur's only private medical college, with state-quota, management-quota and NRI-quota seats.

GMC Churachandpur is the first government medical college in Manipur's hill districts; it received NMC's Letter of Permission for 100 MBBS seats on 23 August 2022.

1.1 Quota Split — JNIMS & GMC Churachandpur (Government, State-Counselled)

AIQ/state-quota splits above are computed from the standard 15%/85% norm applied to government medical colleges nationwide; DHS Manipur publishes the exact whole-number split for each college and round in its official counselling notifications.

1.2 Shija Academy of Health Sciences (Private) — Quota Categories

As Manipur's sole private medical college, SAHS's 150 MBBS seats are distributed across state quota, management quota and NRI quota, with fees varying accordingly (approx. Rs 11–18 lakh/year depending on quota). Candidates from outside Manipur may apply for management/NRI quota seats regardless of domicile. Exact round-wise quota-wise seat counts are released by SAHS/DHS Manipur ahead of each counselling round.

2. RIMS Imphal — Official Seat Distribution (MBBS)

Unlike the standard state-quota model, RIMS Imphal (an autonomous central institute) allocates its 125 MBBS seats across a dedicated North-Eastern regional quota, benefiting neighbouring states, in addition to Manipur's own share, AIQ and EWS seats. 3. Manipur State-Quota Reservation Policy (Category-wise)

For the 85% state-quota seats at JNIMS, GMC Churachandpur and the state-quota share at Shija Academy, Manipur applies the following approximate category-wise reservation, in addition to a 5% horizontal reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PwBD) that cuts across all vertical categories:

Category	Approx. Reservation (State Quota)
Scheduled Tribe (ST)	~31%
Other Backward Classes (OBC / Non-Creamy Layer)	~17%
Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	~10%
Scheduled Caste (SC)	~2%
Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)	5% (horizontal, cuts across categories)
Unreserved / Open	Remainder (~40%)

Manipur's tribal-majority hill districts give ST candidates the largest reservation share of any state in India, while the SC share is comparatively small, reflecting the state's demographic composition. Exact whole-number seat splits per college are published annually in the DHS Manipur MBBS/BDS admission prospectus.

4. BDS Seat Matrix — College-wise

Manipur has two government dental colleges, both attached to its two state/central medical institutes; there is no private BDS college in the state.

4.1 RIMS Imphal — Official Seat Distribution (BDS)

As with MBBS, RIMS Dental College allocates its 50 BDS seats across the North-Eastern regional quota plus AIQ and Manipur's own share. Sourced from the official RIMS website.

Note on figures: College-wise MBBS/BDS totals (525 and 100) are corroborated across the official RIMS website, NMC/DCI approval records, and multiple 2025-26 counselling guidance sources. Category-wise state-quota splits for JNIMS, GMC Churachandpur and Shija Academy are presented as approximate reservation percentages (Section 3) rather than fabricated exact seat counts, since DHS Manipur publishes the precise whole-number, round-wise, college-wise breakup only in its official prospectus and round-wise notifications. Seat matrices are provisional and subject to revision each counselling round (Round 1, Round 2, Mop-Up, Stray Vacancy); always cross-check the latest notification on the official Manipur Medical Council e-counselling portal (manipurmc.mn.gov.in) or the DHS Manipur website before filling choices.
