

Mizoram NEET UG Seat Matrix 2025

MBBS & BDS Seats — Category Wise, Course Wise, Quota Wise Breakdown

Medical undergraduate admission in Mizoram for NEET UG 2025 is conducted through the Department of Higher & Technical Education (DHTE), Government of Mizoram, for the 85% State Quota seats, while the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats are filled centrally by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC). Mizoram currently has one NMC-recognised government medical college and no functional government or private dental (BDS) college, so no BDS seats are allotted through the state counselling.

Note: Zoram Medical College, started in 2018, is the only government medical college in Mizoram, affiliated with Mizoram University, with an annual approved intake of 100 MBBS seats.

BDS Seat Matrix 2025

Mizoram does not have a functioning government or private dental college at present, so **no BDS seats are offered under Mizoram NEET UG counselling for 2025**. Mizoram-domicile candidates seeking a BDS seat must compete for dental seats in other states/institutions through the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) counselling conducted by MCC.

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Category-wise Reservation Policy

(a) All India Quota (15 seats) — Central Reservation Norms

The 15% AIQ seats follow the uniform central reservation policy applicable across all states: 27% for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), 15% for SC, 7.5% for ST, 10% for EWS, and a 5% horizontal reservation for PwD candidates, applied within each category. No state domicile is required for AIQ seats, but the candidate's category must appear on the Central List.

Approximate seat splits are arithmetic estimates applying the national percentages to 15 AIQ seats, rounded to the nearest whole seat; MCC's official round-wise seat matrix should be checked for the exact allotted number in each round, since fractional seats are carried forward/adjusted as per NMC guidelines.

(b) Mizoram State Quota (85 seats) — State Reservation Norms

For the 85% State Quota seats, DHTE Mizoram applies its own reservation framework rather than the central OBC/SC/ST percentages (since Mizoram has a very small Scheduled Caste population and a predominantly Scheduled Tribe/General demographic profile). The broad reservation categories notified for Mizoram State Quota counselling are:

Category	Basis of Reservation
Unreserved (UR) / General	Remaining seats allotted strictly on NEET merit
Other Backward Classes (OBC)	State-notified percentage for OBC candidates
Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)	10% of seats, for EWS candidates from the General category
Persons with Disabilities (PwD)	5% horizontal reservation (minimum 40% disability, state medical board certified)
Ex-Servicemen (ESM) quota	3% reserved for wards/dependents of ex-servicemen
Domicile requirement	Valid Mizoram domicile/residence certificate mandatory for all State Quota seats

Note: DHTE Mizoram has not published a single consolidated numeric break-up (exact seat count per category) of the 85 State Quota seats in the public domain for 2025 at the time of writing. The categories above reflect the officially stated reservation heads; candidates should verify the exact category-wise seat numbers for each counselling round from the official DHTE Mizoram notification at dhte.mizoram.gov.in.

Requirement	Detail
Domicile	Permanent resident of Mizoram with valid domicile certificate
Minimum age	17 years as on 31 December of the admission year
Upper age limit	None, as per NMC rules
Qualifying marks (PCB aggregate)	50% General; 45% PwD; 40% OBC/SC/ST
Academic eligibility	Class 12 (or equivalent) with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English, each passed individually

Counselling Rounds

Mizoram NEET UG state counselling is conducted by DHTE in multiple rounds — Round 1, Round 2, Mop-Up, and Stray Vacancy — with cut-offs generally easing in each subsequent round. AIQ seats are counselled in parallel by MCC (mcc.nic.in), and a candidate may register for both the AIQ and Mizoram state-quota processes simultaneously.
