MBBS & BDS — Government and Private Colleges | Compiled Reference Document

This document compiles publicly available seat-matrix figures for MBBS and BDS admissions in Jammu & Kashmir under NEET UG 2025 counselling, conducted by the Jammu & Kashmir Board of Professional Entrance Examinations (JKBOPEE).
