1. State Overview

Arunachal Pradesh has only **one** medical college offering the MBBS course: the **Tomo Riba Institute of Health & Medical Sciences (TRIHMS)**, located at Naharlagun (near Itanagar). There are no private medical colleges in the state. Admission is through NEET-UG, with counselling conducted by the **Directorate of Higher & Technical Education (DHTE), Government of Arunachal Pradesh** for the state-quota seats, and by the **Medical Counselling Committee (MCC)** for the All-India Quota (AIQ) seats.

2.2 State Quota (85 seats) — Category-wise Indicative Distribution

State-quota seats at TRIHMS are overwhelmingly reserved for candidates holding an Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe (APST) / Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC). The indicative category split below follows the state's standard reservation roster; candidates should confirm the exact round-wise figures on the DHTE portal, as these can shift slightly between rounds due to unfilled-seat carry-forward.

4. Key Facts / FAQ

Q. Does Arunachal Pradesh have any private medical college?

No. As of 2025, all MBBS and PG medical seats in the state are at the single government institute, TRIHMS.

Q. Can a non-domicile (non-APST) candidate get an MBBS seat here?

Yes, only through the 15% All India Quota (AIQ) seats filled by MCC; the 85% state-quota seats are overwhelmingly reserved for APST/domicile candidates.

Q. Is there an NRI quota?

No NRI or management quota is offered at TRIHMS.

Q. Who releases the official seat matrix PDF?

The Directorate of Higher & Technical Education (DHTE), Government of Arunachal Pradesh releases the state-quota matrix; MCC releases the AIQ matrix on mcc.nic.in.
