CATEGORY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27**

**Notification for exercising web-options for Second Phase of Counseling for admission into
MBBS/BDS courses under Management Quota i.e. B & C/NRI Category for the AY 2026-
27 into affiliated Private Medical/Dental Colleges, Army College of Dental Sciences &
Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences affiliated to Anurag University.**

In continuation to this office notifications dated: 12.08.2026, 07.09.2026, 09.09.2026 & 15.09.2026, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences hereby notifies to conduct second phase of web-based counseling under Management Quota i.e. B & C/NRI Category for admission into MBBS/BDS courses for the AY 2026-27 into affiliated Private Medical/Dental Colleges, Army College of Dental Sciences & Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences affiliated to Anurag University.

Candidates whose names are notified as eligible candidates in the final merit list of MBBS/BDS Admissions under Management Quota on the KNRUHS website on 09.09.2026 and subsequent addendums & corrigendums are eligible to exercise web - options through online from computer with internet connection.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the final merit list of Management Quota on KNRUHS website can exercise web options for admission into MBBS/BDS courses from **02.00 PM on 22.09.2026 up to 02.00 PM on 24.09.2026** through website <https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/> as per the candidate's registration and eligibility for B & C/NRI categories.

- 1. The candidates who were allotted seats in the first phase of counselling and have not reported/discontinued the course at the respective medical / dental college are not eligible for exercising web-options.**
- 2. Candidates who have not exercised web-options in the first phase of counselling are not eligible to exercise web-options.**

- 3. The candidates who were allotted MBBS/BDS seats in the first phase of counselling, joined the course and continuing the course are eligible to exercise web-options.**

Candidates have to exercise web options for the MBBS seats in order of preference for college and category under B & C/NRI Category.

For eligibility criteria and regulations refer to notifications dated: 12.08.2026.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Allotted Candidates have to pay the following University fee through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and download the allotment order.

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee is to be paid at the respective Medical/Dental Colleges.

1. The tuition fee payable as notified by the Government of Telangana in G.O.Ms.No. 98, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 07.08.2026.
2. For Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences: Tuition Fee is Rs. 16,50,000/- per annum for B Category and Rs. 24,75,000/- per annum for C/NRI category.

NOTE:

1. The details of vacant seats available (seat matrix) are placed in the website <http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in>. Candidates can exercise web options for MBBS/BDS seats in all Medical/Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS and Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences through <https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/>.
2. In accordance with the G.O.Ms.No. 130, HM&FW (C1) Dept., Dated: 27.09.2022, in Management Quota B category, 85% of seats are reserved for local candidates of Telangana and 15% of seats are open to candidates from all over the country. 15% unreserved seats shall be allotted first followed by seats reserved for local candidates in Management Quota B Category seats.
3. The MBBS seats in Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences are distributed in accordance with the "Telangana State Private Universities (Establishment and Regulation) Act", Act no. 11 of 2018.
4. The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the selection procedure notified

in Government orders G.O.Ms.No. 115 &116, HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 05.07.2017, G.O.Ms.No. 117 & 118 HM&FW(C1) Dept., Dated: 20.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No. 130, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 27-09-2022, G.O. Ms. No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 19-07-2024, G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 08.09.2025 and relevant Hon'ble High Court/Supreme court orders and University regulations.

5. Candidates are informed that they will be considered only to the category/categories to which they have registered. (B& C/NRI)
6. **Candidates in the final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counselling to prevent seat blocking.**
7. **Candidates are informed that if they exercise web- options for a seat and allotted MBBS/BDS seat as per their choice in the web- counseling and if they do not join the course at the allotted college, they will not be eligible for exercising web-options for subsequent rounds of counseling.**

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

1. Eligible NEET-UG-2026 qualified candidates as per final merit list for Management Quota can exercise web options for MBBS/BDS courses in the affiliated Medical/Dental colleges of KNRUHS and Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences as per their interest and priority through <https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/> from computer with internet connection.
2. Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus for the Regulations for admission into MBBS/BDS courses under Management Quota (B & C/NRI category) and Government Orders on Rules of Admission on KNRUHS website before exercising web-options.
3. **If a candidate is allotted a seat in MBBS/BDS course as per his/her options and does not join the course, they shall not be permitted to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.**
4. Candidates exercising web-options for MBBS/BDS courses are informed that there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options. Candidates can exercise web options for any number of courses/colleges the candidate is interested to join as per candidate's eligibility (B & C/NRI category) in order of preference.

5. Candidates are advised to exercise web options for MBBS/BDS seats in all colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available vacant seats shown in seat matrix, as vacancies will arise during counselling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats in first phase of counselling to other seats as per their web-options in the second phase of counselling.
6. If a seat is allotted in this phase of counselling as per web-options exercised by the candidates in this phase of counselling, the seat allotted in first phase of counselling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore, candidates are informed to exercise web-options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.
7. **Candidates in the final merit list are informed that if they do not exercise web options in the first phase of counseling, they are not eligible to exercise web options in subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.**
8. Management Quota seats (B & C/NRI) in Private Minority Medical Colleges are reserved for Muslim Minority candidates only. In case Muslim Minority Candidates are not available, the seats may be filled up with Non-Minority students up to maximum of 30% during final phase of counselling.
9. Allotment of Management Quota seats in Army College of Dental Sciences is reserved for the wards of Army personnel as per AWES regulations.
10. Candidates have to exercise web-options for B category and if eligible for C/NRI in order of their priority for college. Allotments will be made according to the order of preference in the web options exercised by the candidate.
11. One time pass word will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of exercising web-options. The pass word consists of SIX letter code with English capital A to Z. (For details read construction to the candidates before giving options)
12. Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options.
13. Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if allotted. Candidates are also informed to login to check their allotment status on <https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in/> website after each phase of counseling.
14. The selected candidates shall download the allotment order from the website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective Medical College on or before the date specified in the allotment order.

- 15. Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the respective Medical/Dental College before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment order, submit all original certificates, relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee/college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within specified date for joining, the admission will be cancelled automatically and the candidate's options shall not be considered for subsequent phases of counseling to prevent seat blocking.**
16. Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the allotted Medical/Dental College and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University regulations.
17. Candidates allotted seat under NRI quota should produce the relevant sponsorship letter from NRI relative in original along with a copy of Passport/Residence proof/Bank Statement or Pass book of sponsor for NRI category at respective colleges.
18. Original certificates submitted at the time of admissions shall not be returned to the candidate, unless the candidate discontinues the course.
19. Admitted candidates will have to pay discontinuation penalty amount of Rs. 20 lakhs as per Government orders, if they discontinue the course after free exit to get back their original certificates.
- 20. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.**

NOTE:

If any discrepancies are found during the verification of documents or at any stage including after closure of admission, admissions of such candidates will be cancelled and action will be initiated including lodging of Criminal Case before the appropriate authority. The candidate / Parent / Guardian are only held responsible for any wrong claim against NRI Quota admission.
